We need convergent approach to solve complex societal challenges

- Tribes have many objectives, some of which may conflict, that intersect with energy and energy sovereignty
- Solving these problems transcends disciplines and requires system thinking
- Research needs to engage Tribes throughout the process to define the problem and objectives, and embed Indigenous knowledge
